Opportunities to Partner Together

Christian schools, such as Carolina Evangelical Divinity School, depend on friends like you to help with items they need for growth and development but are unable to fund through limited tuition dollars. Tuition usually provides less than forty percent of the needed revenue at evangelical seminaries. Were it not for God's people stepping forward, most schools would be forced to provide less-than-adequate training for those who should be receiving an education appropriate to their high calling. How can you help CEDS return well equipped ministers to those two dozen denominations that have entrusted their spiritual and ministry formation to us? Here are some suggestions...

ADOPT

Adoption is a major theme in Christian theology. Perhaps you or your church family could consider adopting one of the following:

- **\$5,000** will provide a full-time student with tuition, fees, and textbooks for a semester.
- **\$20,000** will provide the annual salary package for a part-time librarian for the divinity school as it transitions to its own academic study center.
- **\$50,000** will provide the annual salary package for a full-time professor at the divinity school.

PROVIDE

Financial Aid - Students in the 21st century are faced with the highest tuition rates ever seen in theological education. At the same time, they are coming to seminary with the largest demands on their personal resources: house payments, children in high school and college, and college loans from recent adult degree completion programs. CEDS must help with financial assistance if these students are to equip themselves for ministry. The divinity school's goal is to provide **\$50,000** each year in scholarships. To that end, we are looking for friends who will commit to providing one of the following:

Library Fund - To provide excellent educational resources for our students, CEDS must keep its library current and relevant. Contributions to the Library Fund will be used to develop the library to 50,000 shelf volumes and to provide the best of the electronic libraries and databases available. Annual Goal: **\$35,000**.

Computer Lab - Students need research access to the internet while on campus, making the Computer Lab a must for seminaries such as CEDS. In the past, our students have had access to the computers at the college with which we have shared a campus. As the divinity school moves to its own academic study center, equipping the Computer Lab is a high priority. Annual Goal: **\$12,000**.

Classroom Technology - Because technology and methods change, there is a constant challenge to keep classrooms equipped with state-of-the-art teaching tools. CEDS is committed to providing its faculty with the laptops, video projection equipment, and other technology it needs to enhance ministry skills for the 21st century. Annual Goal: **\$25,000**.

Professional Development - As with any educational institution, continued investment in the professional development of the faculty is crucial. While faculty members at the divinity school have doctoral degrees in hand when they come to us, CEDS requires that they stay current in their field of expertise and participate in the scholarly guilds. To encourage faculty in their continued growth as teachers and mentors, the divinity school provides financial assistance. Annual Goal: **\$20,000**.
